Student Life

Lodging and Meals

On campus, students will be living in Madrona Hall, a beautiful and newly renovated dorm on UW's North Campus. Students will be housed in a double, sharing a private bathroom with one roommate. Students are housed by gender, and floors are gendersegregated. Dorm rooms contain a Twin XL sized bed, a desk, drawers, mirror, and a closet. Mentors live on same floor as students and are available for any needs. Students will have most of their daily three meals in the on-campus dining hall, with some meals being off campus. The dining hall offers a wide selection of food with buffet style. There are ample food options accommodating vegetarian and vegan options, however, no Kosher or Halal options.
