ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Embedded in cultures the world wide, fashion and design holds center stage for symbolism, meaning and ultimately, self expression. COURSE STRUCTURE

There are 9 class sessions over the two-week course. During the first week, students have class from 9am-12pm, Monday through Friday. During the second week, students have class from 9am-12pm Monday through Thursday. Thursday will be the morning when they present their final projects. Friday morning there is no class, students check out from the program and depart on that day.

TUITION RATES

Residential Students: **\$5,498**

Includes: all meals, lodging, excursions, Academic Course, weekend excursions; Excludes: optional airport pickup/drop off service (available for additional fee)

Commuter Students: **\$2,998**

Includes: lunch, academic course, excursions, programming from 9am to 5pm, Monday-Friday; Excludes: lodging, breakfast, dinner, weekend excursions

Extended Commuter Students: **\$3,598**

Includes: lunch, dinner, excursions, academic course, programming from 9am to 8pm, weekend excursions;

Excludes: lodging, breakfast

TUITION SUPPLEMENTS:

- Application fee: \$99 mandatory, non-refundable
- Group airport transfers: \$95 each way. Transfers outside of the official group pick-up and drop-off time window are \$195 each way (optional)
- Unaccompanied minor transportation: \$50 additional fee each way (if using airport transfer)
