- Application fee: \$99 (mandatory, non-refundable)

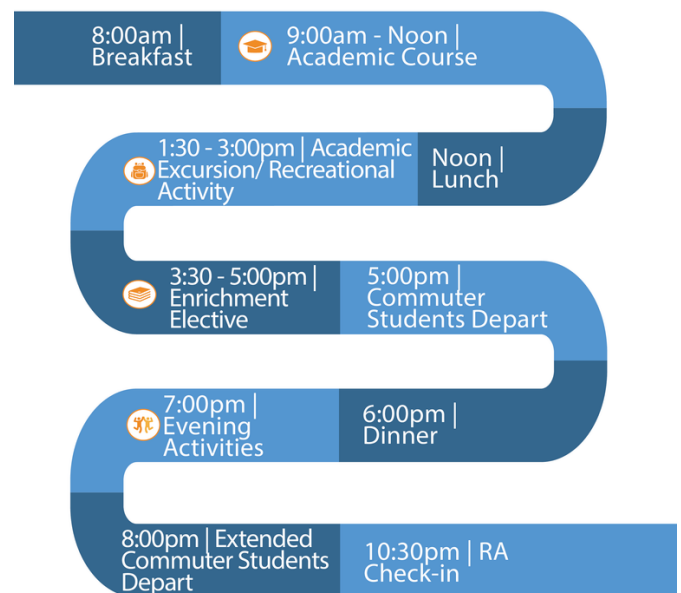


Course Structure
