Interact with experienced doctors, medical students, and residents while immersing yourself in the multifaceted world of medicine.



Excursions

Boston

Students in our Boston program have a hands-on experience in the STRATUS Center (simulation center affiliated with Harvard Medical School), as well as the Boston University School of Medicine where they have the opportunity to meet with Admissions officials, and tour the medical school.

Berkeley

Students will visit the UCSF KANBAR Simulation Center. All students in this program will complete the requirements to receive their CPR certification. They will also rotate/round through various medical disciplines and meet distinguished professionals in those fields. In addition, students may have the opportunity to tour UC Berkeley's Henry H. Wheeler Brain Imaging Center which houses one of the most powerful human research functional Magnetic Resonance Imagine (fMRI) systems in the US.

Residential Students:

- Includes: all meals, lodging, excursions, academic course, weekend excursions

Course Structure
