ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Have you ever dreamed of performing on Broadway? Over the course of this two-week program, students spend three hours each morning doing acting and voice lessons, as well as learning about the fundamentals of playwriting and stage production. Students will work in small groups to put together their own short play for presentation on the last day of the program.

GUEST SPEAKERS AND EXCURSIONS:

Students will have the opportunity to see a Broadway production, as well as get backstage access to a local theater. Speakers include producers and actors who will share their experiences and what it means to be a theater professional.

COURSE STRUCTURE:

There are 9 class sessions over the two-week course. During the first week, students have class from 9am-12pm, Monday through Friday. During the second week, students have class from 9am-12pm Monday through Thursday. Thursday will be the morning when they present their final projects. Friday morning there is no class, students check out from the program and depart on that day.

INSTRUCTORS AND CURRICULUM ADVISOR:

Courses are taught by accomplished and passionate faculty recruited from many area colleges, universities and professional forums. Each faculty member is selected for their subject area expertise and proven ability to both challenge and captivate students.

TUITION RATES

Residential Students: **\$5,498**

Includes: all meals, lodging, excursions, Academic Course, weekend excursions;
Excludes: optional airport pickup/drop off service (available for additional fee)

Commuter Students: **\$2,998**

Extended Commuter Students: **\$3,598**

Includes: lunch, dinner, excursions, academic course, programming from 9am to 8pm, weekend excursions; Excludes: lodging, breakfast

TUITION SUPPLEMENTS:

- Application fee: \$99 (mandatory, non-refundable)
- Group airport transfers: \$95 each way. Transfers outside of the official group pick-up and drop-off time window are \$195 each way (optional)
- Unaccompanied minor transportation: \$50 additional fee each way (if using airport transfer)

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
